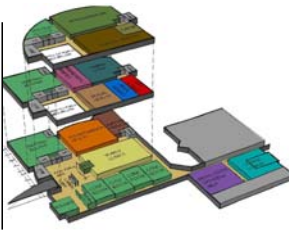

The new facility is being designed with adaptable building systems to allow for maximum flexibility and "state of the art" technology. The building program includes Shared Clinics, Parent Child, Environmental Health, Sexual Health, Dental Health, Immunization and Genetics, Mental Health, Alcohol and Drug Addiction and Administrative Programs. The building will also include Conference Facilities and a Multi Media Centre for distance communication with APH satellites across the District. This project will be collocated in an architecturally congruent manner with Sault College of Applied Arts and Technology to strengthen the link to education and to explore new synergies in operations and program delivery.
