The existing facilities will be replaced with new administration and maintenance buildings, as well as new toll booths.

As is common with most planning exercises, the phasing of new development is crucial. The project not only addresses the needs for the future, but had to integrate a phased approach so as to minimize impact to the daily operations of the toll plaza.

The Administration building contains Plaza Operations and Administrative Offices that can be easily accessed by the public and have a complete visual of the toll booths, the bridge and I-75 to the south. Staff Facilities and Brokerage Offices are also located on Level One. A utility tunnel will connect the Admin building to each of the toll booths.
