The project included the design and construction of a Central Administrative Headquarters and main laboratory facility to be used for health and environmental testing in Kuala Lumpur. It was one of the first to be constructed within the Asian 'Multi-Media Super Corridor', an advanced high technology IT linkage system.

The concept for these buildings is to be sufficiently flexible to allow for anticipated changes in technology, processes, or imperatives, without impeding, restricting or reducing efficiencies of the laboratories.
