The design concept for this project led to the creation of a new "brand" for Pino's Get Fresh. The store's interior is reminiscent of the outdoor and open markets of Italy. The Produce, Bakery, Meat, Dairy and Dry Goods Program areas are broken down into themed food stands which feature and display their respective products.

The exterior design implies a large market style building, with signage bands marketing the specialized foods and products of Pino's. The lobby is outfitted with a large glazed curtain wall, and clerestory strip windows bring natural light into the rest of the store.
