This project involved the design of a new consolidated Acute Care facility, replacing the two existing hospitals in Sault Ste. Marie. EPOH was commissioned to complete a Master Plan, Financial Analysis and as the architects / engineers of record for what would be the City's largest capital project in history.

The new Sault Are Hospital provides the community with 300 beds and a variety of acute health care services located within 33 departments, most notable of which are the new cancer treatment centre and substantial critical and ambulatory care. As a teaching hospital, it also contains space for the Northern Ontario School of Medicine, telehealth facilities, and an auditorium.

The architectural design strategy involves a horizontal model which places unlike building elements independent of one another so as to enable future expansion and flexibility. This design also places all outpatient services at the main entrance level, in an effort to create a patient focused care facility.
