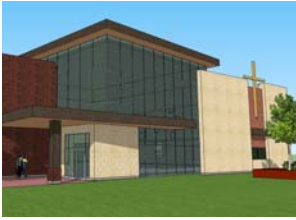


EPOH



This project involves the construction of a new elementary school building located on the existing site of Espanola Catholic Elementary School in Espanola. The original project strategy involved a renovation and addition, but after careful evaluation it was determined that a new building provided much more “value for money”.

In addition to the conventional JK to Grade 8, this new “state of the art” catholic elementary school accommodates unique programs such as special education, Native Second Language, Cultural rooms, Music room, Art room, Resource centre, Science room and Daycare. The main space is 2 1/2 storeys and designed to accommodate student learning commons and a reception space to larger community or parent/student events. The main lobby and library are substantially glazed to maximize natural light during the day and reduce energy costs. The exterior facades are composed of smaller scale elements, compatible with the users and surrounding neighborhood.
