



The West End Community Centre is a municipally owned community centre that evolved from a Feasibility Study and Business Case. The Feasibility Study established market demand for an indoor turf facility by visiting many community stakeholders, such as soccer, football, lacrosse etc. The library and arena programming components form party of a City redevelopment strategy to replace it's aging West End facilities.

The West end Community Centre was conceived as a three to four phase project involving the design and construction of three indoor turf facilities, two ice pads, 100 person capacity spectator seating, community rooms, Public Library branch, Food Court, and administrative offices. Phase 1 and 2 (Turf fields and Public Library) are scheduled to open in Spring of 2012, whereas Phase 3 and 4 will be designed and constructed post 2012. Epoh developed a full masterplan for the site that anticipates multiple implementation phases for both building and outdoor recreational facilities.
